Located just a beautiful one-hour drive north of the Golden Gate Bridge, going to the Lodge makes you feel like you are a world away.

DIRECTIONS & TRANSPORTATION

FROM SAN FRANCISCO AND POINTS SOUTH, VIA 101 NORTH

Take 101 North through San Francisco over the Golden Gate Bridge to Petaluma. Take the East Washington St. exit, and turn left heading west. Stay on this road for 28 miles. The road will change names from Bodega Ave. to Valley Ford Rd. to Hwy 1. The Bodega Bay Lodge & Spa is on the left just after the Links at Bodega Harbour. You will see the Bodega Bay Lodge & Spa sign at the turnoff to Doran Beach at the south end of Bodega Bay.

FROM SANTA ROSA AND POINTS NORTH, VIA 101 SOUTH

At Santa Rosa, exit at the Hwy 12 Junction heading west towards Sebastopol. Follow Hwy 12 through Sebastopol. Hwy 12 then becomes Bodega Hwy. that leads you to a "T" at Hwy 1. Turn right, heading north and follow for 5 miles. The Bodega Bay Lodge & Spa is on the left just after the Links at Bodega Harbour. You will see the Bodega Bay Lodge & Spa sign at the turnoff to Doran Beach at the south end of Bodega Bay.

FROM POINTS EAST, VIA INTERSTATE 80 WEST

At Vallejo, exit at Marine World Parkway, which is Hwy 37. Continue on Hwy 37 until you pass the turnoff for Infineon Raceway. The next stoplight will be a right turn onto Lakeville Rd. Continue to the city of Petaluma. Turn left onto East Washington St. and head west for about 28 miles. The Bodega Bay Lodge & Spa is on the left just after the Links at Bodega Harbour. You will see the Bodega Bay Lodge & Spa sign at the turnoff to Doran Beach at the south end of Bodega Bay.

FROM POINTS EAST, VIA 580 NORTH

Follow I-580 North over the San Rafael/Richmond Bridge to Hwy 101 North. In Petaluma, take the East Washington St. exit and turn left heading west. Stay on this road for 28 miles. The road will change names from Bodega Ave. to Valley Ford Rd. to Hwy 1). The Bodega Bay Lodge & Spa is on the left just after the Links at Bodega Harbour. You will see the Bodega Bay Lodge & Spa sign at the turnoff to Doran Beach at the south end of Bodega Bay.

ACCOMMODATIONS

The Bodega Bay Lodge & Spa has 84 guest rooms, including five junior suites. The Lodge is located on eight acres of beautifully landscaped grounds that overlook Bodega Bay and the Pacific Ocean. Every guest room offers spectacular views, a wood burning fireplace, and a private balcony or patio.



GUEST ROOMS AND SUITES

The Lodge features several different room types:

Pacific Coast Lower Room

These ground floor, ocean view rooms feature a wood-burning fireplace, flat panel TV, newly remodeled bathrooms and a private patio overlooking the Lodge gardens, and spectacular views of Bodega Bay and the Pacific Ocean.

Pacific Coast Double Room

These ocean view rooms are available on the first or second floor and come with two queen beds. Key features include wood-burning fireplaces, flat panel TV, newly remodeled bathrooms and private balconies that overlook the Lodge's gardens, with views of Bodega Bay and the Pacific Ocean. These rooms are perfect for families or those requiring two beds.

Pacific Coast Upper Room

Located on the second floor, these ocean view rooms feature a wood-burning fireplace, flat panel TV, newly remodeled bathrooms and a private balcony overlooking the Lodge gardens, and spectacular views of Bodega Bay and the Pacific Ocean.

Bodega Bay Rooms

These extra large rooms offer an unobstructed, panoramic ocean view with a private balcony overlooking the bird sanctuary. Indulge in plush furnishings that include a king-size bed and wood-



burning fireplace. Some rooms include a separate glass shower, whirlpool bathtub, and vaulted ceiling.

Ocean Club Junior Suites

The Ocean Club Junior Suites are the most luxurious accommodations the Lodge offers. Rich cherry wood furnishings, black granite, ceramic tile, slate, original artwork, and rich fabrics accent the oversized space. The bedroom area has a king size bed, flat panel TV, Bose stereo with MP3 dock, and desk. An archway leads into the living room area with sofa, and a black granite fireplace surrounded with cherry wood shelving. Each room features an iPod docking station, custom molding, an oval jet tub, separate walk-in shower with skylight and a large vanity with double sinks. Panoramic ocean views are spectacular from your private terrace.
