

The Academy of Behavioral Medicine Research announces its second Research Camp, to be held in conjunction with the 2010 Annual Meeting in Bodega Bay, California June 9-13th at the Bodega Lodge and Spa.

ABMR will sponsor 3-4 fellows to attend “research camp” where they will have extended opportunities to discuss their research ideas with senior scientists and to attend the annual conference. The hotel, airfare, meals, and meeting registration costs for the fellows will be paid by ABMR.

The annual meeting is scheduled for Wednesday evening, June 9th through Saturday evening, June 12th, with departure on the morning of Sunday, June 13. The research camp will begin on the evening of Tuesday, June 8th and end on Wednesday afternoon, prior to the opening reception for the main conference that evening. Informal conversations among the fellows and mentors will continue throughout the conference, however and further interactions are anticipated after the conference concludes as well.

Eligibility: Post-doctoral fellows and junior faculty members with recent MDs or PhDs in behavioral medicine/health psychology-related disciplines.

Application materials: Self- and other-nominations will be considered. The Research Camp Selection Committee requires the following application materials: (a) a copy of the candidate’s curriculum vitae; (b) brief self-statement of research interests and/or brief description of the project or grant application for which he or she would like to solicit advice (1 page or less); (c) two letters of support from senior scholars who can comment on the candidate’s qualifications. **The submission deadline is March 31, 2010.** Members of the ABMR Research Camp Committee will inform those who are selected in April or May, 2010.
