Call for Membership Nominations Membership requirements

Materials will be due on October 1 and February 1 of each year, for consideration by the Executive Committee in October and February. This procedure will make it possible for newly elected members to attend the subsequent Annual Meeting, as they will have sufficient time to plan and make the necessary arrangements.

The criteria for eligibility are as follows. The nominee will:

- a) Have made a significant contribution to his or her field, and influenced the work of other scientists, as evidenced by widely cited peer reviewed publications, grants, and editorial boards, or senior administrative roles that have significantly advanced the field; and,
- b) Hold the rank of associate professor or higher, or hold a comparable rank if not an academic.

If there are doubts as to whether one meets the above criteria, the nominators should dispel these doubts in their letters.

Supporting documentation must include two letters of nomination, and a copy of the nominees CV. The nominations may be submitted to the Membership Committee Chair, Peter Kaufmann:
